## Cypress Mountain Regional Mogul Competition

Dear: Freestyle Parents/Guardians/Athletes

The Vancouver Freestyle Ski Club is pleased to invite you to our first regional mogul competition in many years. This will be an informal competition with the feel of a BC Series Event and is geared towards Jump and Bumps and Freestylerz athletes that are looking for competition experience. The 1 day event will be held Saturday March 10<sup>th</sup> 2012 at Cypress Mountain, located just minutes from Vancouver. The mogul course will be situated on the Alex Bilodeau run, venue for the Olympic Freestyle events. The course will be open Friday March 9 for training starting at 12:00 noon, and will be closed at 4 pm to prepare the course for the following day's races. Competition day will follow a typical BC Series schedule, ending with an awards ceremony at 3:30 pm.

## ENTRY AND REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- We ask that all athletes pre-register <http://www.planetreg.com/E21613543924149> (note: some coaches prefer to do the online entry - check with your coach before submitting a duplicate entry.)
- Athletes must have current CFSA Membership and License.
- Registration fees are to be paid at the event **competition office** by **cash or cheque**.
- Bib deposit fees are separate and must be paid with **cash**.

## REGISTRATION COST

- \$30 for Super youth, Youth, Juvenile, and Junior Competitors

## BIB DEPOSIT

- \$20 per athlete (cash only)
- Athletes must wear bib during training and competition. Athletes not wearing appropriate bib may be disqualified.
- Bibs must be returned to **race office**, in good condition, after the event to receive deposit back.

## COMPETITION OFFICE

- The competition office will be located in the Black Mountain Lodge adjacent to the upper parking lot (not the new lodge). The competition office will be used for morning athlete and volunteer registration
- The Race office will be located at the Judging Stand. All race related activities other than athlete and volunteer registration will occur at the Race office, including bib return.

## LIFT TICKETS AT CYPRESS MOUNTAIN

Cypress Mountain offers reduced ticket prices to athletes. To purchase tickets:

- Athletes must purchase tickets at resort ticket booth
- Registered athletes will receive a 40% discount for their lift pass or the respective reciprocal season pass discounts to their home mountain (need to show your home mountain season pass).
- Athletes must show/wear their bib for the discount.



- MC/Visa is accepted
- Ticket office opens at 8:30am daily
- Complimentary lift tickets for coaching staff, judges, officials and volunteers will be available at either the Competition or Race Office each day.

### **BASIC EVENT PROGRAM**

- This is a one day, single mogul, regional event for Super Youth, Youth, Juvenile, and Junior athletes that do not already compete on a regular basis. Though informal, the event will be run to provide a BC Series experience.
- The mogul course will be situated on the Alex Bilodeaux run where the Olympic freestyle events were held. Athletes will access the course from the Raven Chair. Both a full and super Youth course will be available to accommodate competitors of all skill levels.
- A tentative event schedule is attached and will also be posted at the competition and race offices. Changes to the schedule will be posted daily.
- Spectators and media are encouraged to watch these young athletes. A path to the bottom of the mogul course from the parking lot will be clearly marked.
- Medal ceremonies will take place at the end of the competition.

### **AGE CATEGORIES (age before July 1, 2011)**

- Male/Female 5 Super Youth: 11 years or under
- Male/Female 4 Youth 12 - 13 years
- Male/Female 3 Juvenile: 14 - 15 years
- Male/Female 2 Junior: 16 - 18 years

### **TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATIONS**

Cypress Mountain is located just north of West Vancouver on Cypress Bowl Rd (Exit #8 of Highway 1). For maps and directions to the mountain, please visit <http://cypressmountain.com/getting-cypress>

There are no accommodations at Cypress Mountain, but many options can be found in North Vancouver, located 15 to 20 km from the mountain.

### **RULES**

This competition is a 1 day regional event sanctioned by the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association. This competition is being organized by the Vancouver Freestyle Ski Club. The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.

### **STATEMENT OF LIABILITY**

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Vancouver Freestyle Ski Club (organizing committee), Cypress Mountain Resort, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants are



urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

## REFUND POLICY

If a competition is cancelled, \$15 CDN shall be refunded to each athlete registered for that event. If the event is rescheduled at another venue \$15 CDN will be charged to the participating athletes.

Injury Refund Policy: A registered athlete who withdraws from an event before the generation of the start list will receive a refund of 50% of their entry fee. Athletes that appear on the official start list for an event will not be given a refund. No refunds will be given without a written request received no later than 7 days after the completion of the last event day.
